


Cycle Stop, Rochester HOG and LOH worked together to host another successful American Red Cross blood drive on Saturday, April 18th.

The Motorcycle Safety Foundation's <u>ARC - Advanced RiderCourse</u> <u>Overview, General Information and Requirements</u>

The Advanced RiderCourse (ARC) is designed for <u>Licensed Riders</u> wishing to raise their skills to a higher level and consists of approximately 3 ½ hours of classroom activities identifying strategies to manage and reduce risk for safer street riding

The 4 ½ hours of on-cycle range instruction and practice, utilizing the student's own streetlegal motorcycle practices techniques that extend beyond basic riding procedures to improve the performance capabilities of riders, particularly related to overall control, cornering and emergency maneuvers.

- Participation in this course requires physical stamina, motor coordination and mental alertness
- You must possess a valid NY State / Out of State Driver's license with Motorcycle Endorsement
 Verified by RiderCoach prior to participation
- You must provide a Street-Legal Motorcycle; <u>Licensed, Registered, Inspected and Insured</u>
 Verified by RiderCoach prior to participation
- Cost: \$125.00 Payable with registration. Pay to order of: Monroe Community College
- Location: Course begins at Monroe Community College's Applied Technology Center, 1485
 WEST Henrietta Rd, Rochester NY 14623. Then moves to Monroe Community College, 1000
 East Henrietta Rd, Rochester NY 14623, Parking lot M-1
- Class size: 12 maximum (6 minimum) or class is postponed until minimum is attained
- Experience: You should have at least <u>1000</u> miles of diversified street riding before taking this
 course

PERSONAL REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

- Helmet--minimum DOT approved
- · Eye protection--face shield, safety glasses or goggles
- Gloves: Full Fingered (NO fingerless gloves)
- Jeans: Denim or other sturdy material, NO FLARE LEG JEANS OR JEANS WITH HOLES
- Jacket: Denim or other sturdy material
- Boots: Must cover the ankle and have as flat a heel as possible
- Passengers are NOT permitted in this RiderCourse
